3pm: Onsite camping opens

Saturday 6/12/2021 Race Day Schedule:

- **Bag Drop:**
 - 60 Mile Riders: leave at 8:00AM for aid station.
 - 30 Mile Riders: leave at 8:00AM for aid station.
 - FSA Riders: No bag drop
 - **NOTE: there will be a bag drop at the lap lane at race start/finish**
- **60 Mile Riders –**
 - **Bib Pick up: 6:30AM-8:00AM**
 - Start Time Male Open, 40-49 & SS: 8:30AM
 - Start Time Female ALL & Men's 50+: 8:35AM
- **30 Mile Riders –**
 - **Bib Pick up: 7:00AM – 8:30AM**
 - Start Time Male OPEN, Male 40-49 & SS: 8:40AM
 - Start Time Male 50+ and Jrs: 8:45AM
 - Start Time Female ALL: 8:55AM
- **FSA 17 Mile Riders – All**
 - **Bib Pick up: 8:00AM-9:00AM**
 - Start Time Male ALL: 9:00AM
 - Start Time Female ALL: 9:05AM

Cutoff 60 Mile: 2:00pm for 2nd loop

Cutoff 60 Mile: 4:30pm for 4th loop

1: Parking and Start Location:

Parking will be available at the Echo Valley Ski area. We will have parking attendants available to assist you with this process.

The start AND finish will be at Echo Valley Ski Lodge.

2: Course flow, Loops, Finish

With the addition of newly built Bobs trail the course is 15 mile loops this year.

Course Markings: The course will be marked extensively with **pink** and **orange** clip-on streamers, yellow caution tape, and directional arrows.

Course Etiquette

When on the course please be sure to use courtesy, call out when passing and if someone is calling out to pass move over and allow that person to pass.

****Anyone that uses un-sportsman like conduct is subject to be pulled from the race and if needed the series.**

3: Aid/Drop Bags

There will be 2 aid stations loop, which are accessed twice for the 30 mile riders and four times for the 60 mile riders and one aid station for the FSA riders..

Both aid stations will have water, heed (pre-mixed and individual packets) and Hammer Gels.

Aid #1 Lap Lane: Bag drop anytime prior to your race this aid station will be at the start/finish lap lane.

Aid #2 Remote: Due to COVID measures we will have a second bag drop at the remote aid station all drop bags will leave no later than 8:00AM and will return by 5:00PM.

*****IMPORTANT*****

When coming through on your last lap at Aid #1 (2x per loop, so basically 1st time on 30 Miler, 3rd time on 60 Miler), you can drop your bag in the return pile, or else you will either need to wait until the race is over or drive to Aid #2 and pick up your drop bag.

Finish Race Food, Drinks, all at the Awards, Raffle will all be at the Finish Line starting when first riders finish.

4: Volunteers:

These events rely heavily on volunteers from set up to take down. You can offer to volunteer for Sunday with the trail runs and get 50% off your bike fee. Or if you have a friend or family member that would like to come out and volunteer, you can still receive 50% off your registration. Already signed up? You can use your credit towards any of our Epic races.
